


## Ceribell 10 Lead Ordering Workflow

This tip sheet details the steps to order, document, and charge for the Point of Care (POC) EEG **Ceribell** procedure. Final interpretations of this procedure may be performed by either a Remote EEG POC Reading Group (“Teladoc”) or a Local Facility Physician/EEG-Read Team., depending if the facility is live with the Teladoc service.

### Try It Out: **Facilities with Teladoc Remote Reading Group**

1. From the Orders activity, search for “**Ceribell**” and select the POC Headband EEG 10 Lead - Ceribell order.



2. Review the Process Instructions, which provides the phone number for the Teladoc Call Center.
3. The Final interpretation section, will be defaulted to indicate that it will be performed by the **Teladoc Remote Reading Group**.


*Note: If the interpretation will be done by a local facility reading group, the physician/provider will manually select the corresponding option.*

4. Input the appropriate phone number for Teladoc to call back with emergency results.
5. Address all other required sections  and when ready **Accept** and **Sign** the order.



**Note:** In the event that the interpretation group needs to be changed to the **Local Facility Reading Group**, the order would require modification and the Teladoc Call Center notified via phone call.

- Once the order is signed, the patient will appear on the POC/Headband EEG – 10 Lead (All Patients & Teladoc Reading) system lists.



Within the BPA, you are required to click the Notification Acknowledged button and a comment can be free-texted if necessary.



- The ordering provider will then perform the procedure/scan of the patient. Once the scan is complete, the provider will need to call the Teladoc Call Center, to inform them that the scan is ready to be reviewed.


8. Once the Teladoc Provider has reviewed and filed their interpretation of the scan, the final order result report can be accessed via an [Epic PDF link](#), found in the patient's chart, under the **Procedures** tab in **Chart Review**.

9. Bedside physicians, who utilize CLARITY artificial intelligence or brain stethoscope options, may write a **Bedside Interpretation Note**. This **Procedure note**, will be documented using the NoteWriter, in the Notes activity. Once the Procedures note type is selected, proceed with clicking Accept, to bring in the Bedside Procedure Note (NoteWriter Template).





## Try It Out: Local Facilities Reading Group (facilities w/o Teladoc)


- From the Orders activity, search for “**Ceribell**” and select the POC Headband EEG 10 Lead - Ceribell order.




- Review the Process Instructions.
- The final interpretation section, will be defaulted to performed by the **Local Facility Reading Group**.
- Address all other required sections  and when ready **Accept** and **Sign** the order.




- Once the order is signed, the patient will appear on the POC/Headband EEG – 10 Lead (All Patients & Teladoc Reading) system lists.




- The neurologist may access the patient's chart to write a **Procedure note**, in the **Notes** activity. They will need to search 'Ceribell' in the **Insert SmartText** field search bar to open the Rapid Response Headband EEG Report template.




- Upon clicking the Sign button, you will be presented with the charge capture pop up. Scroll down to the POC/Headband EEG – 10 Lead section, choose the associated charge and click **Accept Session**. Signing the note completes the order and the patient falls off the system list.



- The completed Ceribell interpretation can be seen in the Procedures tab of the Chart Review activity, along with regular EEG orders.



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- They will need to search 'Ceribell' in the **More Procedures** search bar, to find and access the Ceribell Bedside Interpretation Note SmartForm. Make the appropriate selections and **Sign**.
